



## GENERAL REGULATIONS 2010

### WHAT IS “ACTES” AND WHAT DO WE DO?

**ACTES** (Asociación Cultural Testimonio Social) was born in 2005 through the initiative of different social groups with the aim of creating a discussion forum about Human Rights issues all over the world and around the different forms of Human Rights violations, those things we see happening everyday and everywhere.

For that purpose, ACTES organises the **International Film Festival of Human Rights**, an open event of free entry and admission. It is based on screenings of film and audiovisual productions, either documentaries or fiction, under the HUMAN RIGHTS topic.

Since then, ACTES has organised the last editions of the International Film Festival of Human Rights that has been taken to Madrid, Alicante, Alcoy, Ponferrada, Cadiz, Villena y Burjassot (Spain) and also México, Chile, Argentina, Guatemala and Ecuador (Latin America).

### OBJECTIVES

The main objective of our Festival is to **increase awareness about universal problems**, as a consequence of human rights violations, also showing the role played by international cooperation in sensitizing and diffusing these illegal acts.

We'd also like to promote and spread all those “social awareness” films and audiovisual productions that hardly have access to commercial outlets, although they are excellent in both realization and content.

### DATE AND PLACE

The **International Film Festival of Human Rights** is an event open to the public; the admission is free and without restrictions. The aim is to screen some cinematographic productions and audiovisual presentations, documentaries and/or fiction, under the heading “Human Rights”. This is an International Festival and it will take place in several countries.

The films to be screened will be chosen by a Committee that is in charge of this task. The entry is free.

## **GENERAL REGULATIONS**

All kinds of audio-visual films in any language, nationality and length, can take part in this Festival.

Contestants can submit films freely and everyone who has the rights to the films can do so: Producers, Filmmakers, Directors, Distributors or any kind of organisation.

All films that are not in Spanish must enclose the script or a text translated at least into English and if possible into Spanish.

All submitted audiovisuals must be in DVD format and with the official entry form enclosed and properly completed.

The entrants can also provide promotional material with its audiovisual work so it can be used with communicative and promotional purposes if the film is finally chosen.

On our web page you will find an automatic registry system. The final date to send the productions is the 31th of March 2010, we won't accept any film later for this edition. Films submitted after this date will be included for the next year's selection. In summer 2010 we will notify if the film has or has not been selected to be screened in the Festival.

## **SELECTION COMMITTEE**

The Selection Committee designated by the International Organization is responsible for the pre-screening and selection of the films to elaborate the final program scheduling.

This Committee will be made up of members of:

- NGOs
- Teachers and Academics
- Cultural Agents
- ACTES Representative
- Several Mass Media Professionals
- Filmmakers

The Festival selection criteria will consider the content, cinematographic quality and originality. The decision of the selection process will be communicated to the entrants by e-mail during summer.

If the film is not selected, we'll contact the entrant sending him/her a letter of commitment signed by the Festival manager guaranteeing that those works that have not been selected will neither be used nor screened.

Likewise, if so wished, the contestants can withdraw their materials at the above mentioned address.

## EXHIBITION RIGHTS

It is important for us to confirm the organisation hereby agrees to respect the author's work and not to broadcast it outside the Festival without the author's expressed consent. The organisation will establish the schedule, venue and date of screenings.

The organisation preserves its right to screen it in any venue of the Festival, and also making last minute changes in the schedule/programme. The selected films will become part of our archive. The organisation will be able to use them in further editions of the Festival, only with educational and non profit purposes.

We remind that this is a non-profit organisation and that the entrance to the participating cinemas is free.

The inscription supposes the acceptance of these bases, as well as of the decisions of the organization and the committee of selection. Any question not foreseen in the bases, will be solved by the organization.
